

Dear Mr. Parker and Mr. Bradford:

I represent John McIlvenna, Mitch Vasin and Peter Blandino, who are current US Airways pilots employed by America West Airlines prior to the merger ("West Pilots"), and the America West Airline Pilots' Protective Alliance ("AWAPPA"), an organization formed for the purpose of protecting the unique interests of the West Pilots.

The purpose of this letter is to put you on notice that it is my clients' position that the Nicolau Award, which was a product of a process agreed to by the Company in the Transition Agreement and which has since been accepted by the Company, is not subject to modification by the Company, either unilaterally or through negotiations with USAPA. My clients sincerely hope that USAPA will live up to its campaign promises and that it and the Company will quickly negotiate a single collective bargaining agreement covering both the West and East pilots that will bring them the long overdue pay, benefit and quality of life improvements to which they are entitled. However, it is their position that USAPA and the Company may not lawfully modify the Nicolau Award as part of those negotiations or otherwise. In the event they do, my clients will seek both injunctive relief and damages against the Company and USAPA.
